Indian Institute of Technology Bhubaneswar is established by the government of India in 2008 under The Institutes of Technology Act 1961 with Amendments up to 2012. IIT Bhubaneswar became an Institute of National Importance from 29 June 2012. The Institute started functioning from the campus of IIT Kharagpur on 22<sup>nd</sup> July 2008 and shifted its operation to the city of Bhubaneswar on 22nd July 2009. The Institute has started all academic operations from the permanent campus at Argul from academic session 2015- 16. The permanent campus of IIT Bhubaneswar spreads over 936 Acres of land which is now developed into a serene, green and wellness campus. It is situated at the foot of Barunei Hill, which is famous for its rich history. The Institute has adopted the concept of Schools rather than Departments for promoting inter-disciplinary research. The Institute currently has 7 schools that offer undergraduate, postgraduate and research courses leading to B.Tech., M.Tech., Dual Degree (B.Tech. + M.Tech.), B.Sc. B.Ed.
