Jamia Millia Islamia, established in 1920 in Aligarh and later relocated to New Delhi, achieved the status of a Central University through an act of Parliament in 1988, after being declared a Deemed to be University by the University Grants Commission in 1962. Its renowned Central Library, the Dr. Zakir Husain Library, named after the former President of India and Vice-Chancellor of Jamia spans an impressive 100,000 square feet. The library holds a vast collection of 400,000+ books, including rare manuscripts, rare books, old serials and offers access to over 7,500 e-journals and databases. Fully automated, it provides on-campus and remote access to its extensive resources. The Dr. Zakir Husain Library also serves as a center of academic excellence, offering academic programs such as a Master's and Bachelor's degrees in Library and Information Science, as well as a Postgraduate Diploma in Preservation, Conservation, and Digitization in Libraries and Archives.
