About INFLIBNET

The Information and Library Network (INFLIBNET) Centre was established in May 1996 as an independent, autonomous Inter-University Centre (IUC) of the University Grants Commission (UGC). Major activities and services of the Centre include automation of academic libraries and information centres, creation of union databases of resources available in academic libraries, promote resource sharing among academic libraries, promote information access and transfer, support scholarship, learning and academic pursuits. The Centre acts as a nodal agency for networking of libraries and information centres in universities, institutions of higher learning and R & D institutions in India with an aim to promote scholarly communication. The technology being a driving force in the contemporary education system, the INFLIBNET Centre has taken-up a number of initiatives for academic community in universities under its purview.

Aims and Objectives of the Training Programme

The Open Science Framework (OSF) is a collaboration tool that helps research groups to work on projects limited to a few people or make it publicly accessible for wider dissemination among peers. OSF promotes open centralized workflows enabling users to capture various aspects of the research lifecycle. The entire workflow starting from developing an idea of research to publishing a paper or report can be efficiently and effectively managed in the OSF.

OSF enables researchers to work collaboratively on different projects simultaneously. It helps to develop a research idea, design a study, store and analyze collected research data, and write and publish a research report/paper. It is a free, open-source software platform which integrates many third-party software that are useful in conducting research work. Researchers will be able to promote their work and achievements using this open platform.

The workshop will provide hands-on training on OSF.

Target Participants

Library and Information professionals, System and Network Administrators, Information Scientists and others with similar responsibilities with exposure to network and information security. A maximum of 30 candidates will be selected for the workshop on First Come First Served basis.

Pre-requisite

Participants should be conversant with basic ICT terminologies, should possess basic knowledge and experience with digitization, library automation will be preferred.

Workshop Fee

The registration fee is Rs. 3,540.00 (Rupees Three thousand Five hundred Forty only) per person without accommodation and Rs. 5,900.00 (Rupees Five thousand Nine hundred only) with accommodation which is inclusive of GST rates. It covers the cost of training programme kit containing training materials, breakfast, lunch and dinner during the training period. The payment should be made through Demand Draft in favour of INFLIBNET Centre payable at Gandhinagar along with filled-in registration form. Fee is non-refundable and non-adjustable. The Centre also accepts payment by NEFT /RTGS for the workshop. The bank account details will be shared on request.

Accommodation

The Centre will arrange accommodation during the period of training at INFLIBNET Guest House (A/C Room) on twin sharing basis. The participants must send prior intimation and charges for accommodation along with registration fees. The accommodation will be provided first come first served basis.
