#### **About INFLIBNET**

### **About Retrospective Conversion**

Retrospective conversion is one of the important tasks at the time of automating the library. There are five ways of retrospective conversion such as I) direct entry from the accession register to the ILMS, II) use of excel or access for data entry III) migration from one software to another software and IV) copying catalogue from external sources. V) Online Copy-Catalogue System (OCS). INFLIBNET Centre has already developed an OCS Application to get the ready made catalogue from IndCat and also developed an open source utility for converting data into MARC format. This training programme includes lectures as well as extensive hands-on training which will provide both theoretical as well as practical exposure to the participants.

# **Objectives of the Programme**

- To understand the features and functionalities of Union Catalogue;
- To use the Online Copy-Catalogue System (OCS);
- To understand the MARC Standard;
- To know various tools and techniques of Retrospective Conversion;
- To maintain the data quality using different standards and techniques;
- To migrate/convert bibliographic records to MARC format;

#### **Major Topics**

- Introduction of Union Catalogue with its features and functionalities
- Overview of Retrospective Conversion
- Understanding MARC (Machine Readable Catalogue) and AACR-II
- Copy Cataloguing from IndCat and Library of Congress

- Overview of Online Copy-Catalogue System (OCS) with its features and functionalities
- Data Conversion/Migration using MARCEdit

#### **Resource Persons**

The resource persons are eminent, experienced Computer and LIS Scientists from the INFLIBNET Centre.

#### **Target Participants**

Library professionals working in universities/colleges who are interested in retrospective conversion of bibliographic data, policy makers, students, information scientists etc.

A maximum of 30-40 candidates will be selected for the workshop on First-Come-First-Served basis.

#### **Training Fee**
