



# Three Days Online Training Programme on Creation and Management of Digital Library using Open Source Software

14 - 16 March 2022

## About INFLIBNET

The Information and Library Network (INFLIBNET) Centre was established in May 1996 as an independent, autonomous Inter-University Centre (IUC) of the University Grants Commission (UGC). Major activities and services of the Centre include automation of academic libraries and information centres, creation of union databases of resources available in academic libraries, promote resource sharing among academic libraries, promote information access and transfer, support scholarship, learning and academic pursuits. The Centre acts as a nodal agency for networking of libraries and information centres in universities, institutions of higher learning and R & D institutions in India with an aim to promote scholarly communication. The technology being a driving force in the contemporary education system, the INFLIBNET Centre has taken-up a number of initiatives for academic community in universities under its purview.

## Aims and Objectives of the Training Programme

This workshop is intended to equip participants with skills for developing and managing their own digital collections. There will be lectures as well as intensive demonstration sessions by experts in the field. Thus it will provide both theoretical and practical skills to the participants.

The objective of the training program is to create awareness in new developments in the field of Library and Information Science like managing information sources in digital environment, building and managing institutional repository without much dependency on the technical experts.

### Following topics will be covered in the workshop:

- ❖ Introduction to open source s/w and working with Linux: Basic commands
- ❖ Institutional Repositories using Dspace
- ❖ Metadata Standards for Digital Collection
- ❖ Digital collection building using Dspace 6.x: Administration and Customization

- ❖ Digital collection building using Dspace 6.x: Workflow and Submissions
- ❖ Digital collection building using Dspace 6.x: Backup, Import and Export

### Resource Persons

The resource persons are eminent IT/Computer/LIS Scientists/professionals and experts of the country.

### Target Participants

Library and Information professionals, System and Network Administrators, Information Scientists and others with similar responsibilities. A maximum of 25 candidates will be selected on a First-Come-First-Serve basis.

### Duration: Three Days (14 - 16 March 2022)

Total Six Sessions (2 Sessions per day) including theory and demonstration. No separate hand-on practical sessions will be conducted.

### Pre-requisite

Participants should be conversant with basic ICT terminologies, should possess basic knowledge and experience with digitization, library automation will be preferred.

### Venue

The Training programme will be conducted online.

### Workshop Fee

The registration fee is Rs. 1,180 (Rupees One thousand one hundred eighty only) per person which is inclusive of GST rates. Fee is non-refundable and non-adjustable. The Centre accepts payment by NEFT /RTGS for the workshop.
