About INFLIBNET

The Information and Library Network (INFLIBNET) Centre was established in May 1996 as an independent, autonomous Inter-University Centre (IUC) of the University Grants Commission (UGC). Indian Research Information Network System (IRINS) is the Web-based research information management and network system developed by the Information and Library Network (INFLIBNET) Centre under the National Mission on Education through ICT (NME-ICT-III). The portal facilitates the academic, R&D organizations, faculty members, and scientists to collect, curate and showcase their scholarly communication activities and provides an opportunity to create the scholarly network. IRINS is available as free software-as-a-service to the academic and R&D organizations in India. IRINS supports the research scholars and students in finding the desired faculty members in their respective areas of interest for research work and higher studies. The system facilitates the faculty members to share their research contributions to the academic community and bring more visibility to their research works. Also, it supports the faculty members in doing collaborative research in their respective areas of expertise and increasing national and international funding opportunities.

Objectives of the Workshop

The main objective of this workshop is to give a brief overview on Researcher's Identification like ORCID, ResearcherID, Google Scholar ID, etc, and Research Profiling & Research Information Management System, and its use in the scholarly community; to bring more awareness about free & open source research information management systems, free and open data source, etc.; to provide an overview of various publication metrics such as citation, social media metrics and smart metrics, etc.

- ❖ Nodal Officer dashboard and report generation (Hands-On Training)

Resource Persons

The resource persons are eminent Scientists from the INFLIBNET Centre and experts from outside premier organizations.

Target Participants

Library and Information Professionals, Research Administrators, IRINS Coordinators, Faculty members, Scientists, Research Scholars, and Students etc. A maximum of 30 candidates will be selected for the workshop on a First-Come-First-Served basis.

Workshop Fee

The registration fee is **Rs. 5,900.00** (Rupees Five Thousand Nine Hundred only) per person with accommodation and **Rs. 3,540.00** (Rupees Three Thousand Five Hundred Forty only) per person without accommodation inclusive of GST. It covers the cost of a training programme kit containing training materials and lunch during the training period. The payment should be made through Demand Draft in favour of INFLIBNET Centre payable at Gandhinagar along with filled-in registration form. Fee is non-refundable and non-adjustable.

Accommodation

The Centre will arrange accommodation during the period of the workshop at the INFLIBNET Guest House (A/C Room) on a twin sharing basis. The participants must submit prior intimation and pay for accommodation along with registration fees.
